Supreme Court: **Eleventh Justice**

Eleven Supreme Justices

1. Eleven Supreme Justices shall be appointed for Twenty Year Terms, and every Two Years One New (or incumbent or former) Supreme Justice is selected by the President and Submitted to the Senate for approval.

Supreme Chief Justice

1. the Eleventh Justice will be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, picked solely out of the Supreme Justices from the Federal Supreme Court for an additional Score Term or till Resignation or Incapableness, without Term Limits. All Living and Capable US Presidents will Form a Panel and make the Appointment with any tie or split decision going to a Panel of All Living and Capable Vice Presidents with only being able to serve on one panel, and if they do not come to a Majority Consensus the Sitting President will make the Final Selection.

Supreme Chief Justice's Additional Powers

1. The Chief Supreme Justice will pick who sits on either Five Supreme Justice Panels, and assigns cases to the panels on a Coin Toss on which Supreme Justice Panel gets the Case.

2. The Supreme Chief Justice can Object to any Ruling of a Five Justice Panel and bring it up for an Eleven Justice Supreme Super Panel with the Supreme Chief Justice as the Supreme Head Justice.

Case Selection

1. Each Supreme Court Panel will select its own cases, but has to take the Cases assigned by Coin Toss by the Chief Supreme Justice to them.

2. The Chief Supreme Justice will Select Cases appealed to the Federal Supreme Court and assign them by Coin Toss to the Two Five Justice Panels. But the Chief Supreme Justice cannot select more than Half of the Cases being Heard by the Two Five Supreme Justice Panels in a Biennial Period.

Tied Panels and Panels without Consensus

1. A Tied Panel or a Panel that cannot reach a Consensus will at first be offered to the Chief Supreme Justice for an Eleven Justice Super Panel, and if passed on by the Chief Supreme Justice it goes to the other Five Justice Panel if they want to take the Case, otherwise it defaults as No Consensus Reached (or another more suiting term).

Constitutional Referendum

1. Upon Granting this Bill a Constitutional Referendum will be held within 180 days to Amend the wording in Article III, Section 1, “shall hold their Offices during good Behavior” to “shall serve their Score Term in good Behavior” and if the Referendum Fails than so too does this Bill, and is retroactively considered Null and Void.
